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**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4200, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. KENNEDY OF MINNESOTA**

Strike section 2821 (page 514, beginning line 19)
and insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 2821. PREPARATION OF REPORTS AS PART OF 2005**
2 **BASE CLOSURE ROUND REGARDING FUTURE**
3 **INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE**
4 **ARMED FORCES.**

5 Section 2912 of the Defense Base Closure and Re-
6 alignment Act of 1990 (part A of title XXIX of Public
7 Law 101-510; 10 U.S.C. 2687 note), as added by section
8 3001 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
9 Year 2002 (Public Law 107-107; 115 Stat. 1342), is
10 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
11 section:

12 “(e) INFRASTRUCTURE-RELATED REPORTS.—

13 “(1) REQUIRED REPORTS.—The Secretary shall
14 prepare the following reports related to infrastruc-
15 ture requirements for the Armed Forces:

16 “(A) A report containing the Integrated
17 Global Presence and Basing Strategy of the De-
18 partment of Defense, including the location of
19 long-term overseas installations, installations to
20 be used for rotational purposes, and forward



1 operating locations, anticipated rotational plans
2 and policies, and domestic and overseas infra-
3 structure requirements associated with the
4 strategy.

5 “(B) A report describing the anticipated
6 infrastructure requirements associated with the
7 probable end-strength levels and major military
8 force units (including land force divisions, car-
9 rier and other major combatant vessels, air
10 wings, and other comparable units) for each of
11 the Armed Forces resulting from force trans-
12 formation.

13 “(C) A report describing the anticipated
14 infrastructure requirements related to expected
15 changes in the active component versus reserve
16 component personnel mix of the Armed Forces.

17 “(D) A report describing the anticipated
18 infrastructure requirements associated with the
19 so-called ‘10-30-30 objective’ of the Secretary
20 to ensure that military forces are capable of de-
21 ployment overseas within 10 days in sufficient
22 strength to defeat an enemy within 30 days and
23 be ready for redeployment within 30 days after
24 the end of combat operations.



1 “(E) A report containing the results of a
2 complete reassessment of the infrastructure
3 necessary to support the force structure de-
4 scribed in the force-structure plan prepared
5 under paragraph (1) of subsection (a) and de-
6 scribing any resulting excess infrastructure and
7 infrastructure capacity, which were previously
8 required by paragraph (2) of such subsection.
9 The reassessment shall be based on actual in-
10 frastructure, facility, and space requirements
11 for the Armed Forces rather than a compara-
12 tive study between 1989 and 2003.

13 “(F) A report describing the anticipated
14 infrastructure requirements associated with the
15 assessment prepared by the Secretary pursuant
16 to section 2822 of the National Defense Au-
17 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2004 (Public
18 Law 108-136; 117 Stat. 1726), in which Con-
19 gress required the Secretary to assess the prob-
20 able threats to national security and determine
21 the potential, prudent, surge requirements for
22 the Armed Forces and military installations to
23 meet those threats.

24 “(2) TIME FOR SUBMISSION OF REPORTS.—The
25 Secretary shall submit the reports required by para-



1 graph (1) to the congressional defense committees at
2 the same time as the Secretary transmits the rec-
3 ommendations for the closure or realignment of mili-
4 tary installations under section 2914(a).”.
