 inter- and intra-branch official communications; executive

At the appropriate place in the section relating to separate orders, insert the following new subsection:

1 () ENHANCED PARALLEL CITATIONS.—During the 2 114th Congress, to the maximum extent practicable, an 3 instruction or reference in a bill or joint resolution to a 4 law or any section thereof not contained in a codified title 5 of the United States Code shall include, if available, the 6 applicable United States Code citation in parenthesis im-7 mediately following the designation of the matter ref-8 erenced or proposed to be modified. If no United States 9 Code citation is available, the parallel citation shall reference the applicable Public Law citation. 10
