1	SECTION 1. REQUIRING SPECIFIC CONSTITUTIONAL AU-
2	THORITY STATEMENT FOR BILLS, JOINT RES-
3	OLUTIONS, CONFERENCE REPORTS, AND
4	CERTAIN AMENDMENTS.

5 Clause 7(c) of rule XII of the Rules of the House6 of Representatives is amended to read as follows:

7 "(c)(1) A bill or joint resolution may not be intro8 duced unless the sponsor submits for printing in the Con9 gressional Record a statement citing the specific power or
10 powers granted to Congress in the Constitution to enact
11 the bill or joint resolution.

12 "(2) A Senate bill or joint resolution may not be con-13 sidered unless the chair of a committee of jurisdiction sub-14 mits the statement required under subparagraph (1) as 15 if the chair were the sponsor of the Senate bill or joint 16 resolution.

"(3) An amendment in the nature of a substitute and
any amendment to a Senate bill or joint resolution may
not be offered unless the sponsor submits the statement
required under subparagraph (1) as if the amendment
were a bill or joint resolution.

"(4) A conference report may not be considered unless the managers on the part of the House submit the
statement required under subparagraph (1) as if the conference report were a bill or joint resolution.

"(5) At the time a bill, joint resolution, amendment,
 or conference report to which this paragraph applies is
 first considered in the House or in the Committee of the
 Whole House on the State of the Union (as the case may
 be), the Clerk shall read the statement submitted under
 this paragraph with respect to the bill, joint resolution,
 amendment, or conference report.

8 "(6) A statement submitted under this paragraph 9 shall not be considered to cite a specific power or powers 10 granted to Congress in the Constitution unless the state-11 ment cites the specific article (including an article added 12 by amendment), section (if any), clause (if any), and sen-13 tence (if any) in which the power is cited.

"(7) Each statement submitted under this paragraph
shall appear in a portion of the Record designated for that
purpose and be made publicly available in electronic form
by the Clerk.".
