## 2 SECTION 1. VOTING BY DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA DELEGATE

**3 IN COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE.** 

4 (a) PERMITTING VOTES TO BE CAST.—Clause 3(a)
5 of rule III of the Rules of the House of Representatives
6 is amended by inserting before the first sentence the fol7 lowing: "In a Committee of the Whole House on the state

of the Union, the Delegate from the District of Columbia
 shall possess the same powers and privileges as a Member
 of the House."

4 (b) APPOINTMENT OF CHAIR.—The first sentence of 5 clause 1 of rule XVIII of the Rules of the House of Rep-6 resentatives is amended by striking "a Member" and in-7 serting "a Member or the Delegate from the District of 8 Columbia".

9 (c) REPEATING OF CERTAIN VOTES.—Clause 6 of 10 rule XVIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives 11 is amended by adding at the end the following new para-12 graph:

13 "(h) Whenever a recorded vote on any question has been decided by a margin within which the vote cast by 14 15 the Delegate from the District of Columbia has been decisive, the Committee of the Whole shall rise and the Speak-16 17 er shall put such question de novo without intervening motion. Upon the announcement of the vote on that question, 18 19 the Committee of the Whole shall resume its sitting without intervening motion.". 20
