

Amendment #5 offered by Rep. Polis of Colorado

In rule 8, after subsection (a), insert the following new subsection and redesignate subsequent subsections accordingly:

“Prohibition on Legislation Addressing More Than One Issue

“(b)(1) It shall not be in order to report a resolution providing for consideration of a bill, joint resolution, or conference report to accompany a bill or joint resolution that is major legislation and advances more than one issue, or a resolution making in order a manager’s amendment to a bill or joint resolution that is major legislation and advances more than one issue.

“(2)(A) For the purpose of this subsection, the term ‘major legislation’ means legislation that is not a Sense of Congress or naming bill and would have a substantial impact on the American people.

“(B) For the purpose of this subsection, the term ‘advances only one issue’ means that the proposition focuses on one scope and object.”
