2 SECTION 1. VOTING BY DELEGATES AND RESIDENT COM-

MISSIONER IN COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE.

4 (a) PERMITTING VOTES TO BE CAST.—Clause 3(a)
5 of rule III of the Rules of the House of Representatives
6 is amended by inserting before the first sentence the fol7 lowing: "In a Committee of the Whole House on the state

of the Union, each Delegate and the Resident Commis sioner shall possess the same powers and privileges as
 Members of the House.".

4 (b) APPOINTMENT OF CHAIR.—The first sentence of 5 clause 1 of rule XVIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives is amended by striking "Member" and insert-6 7 ing "Member, Delegate, or the Resident Commissioner". 8 (c) REPEATING OF CERTAIN VOTES.—Clause 6 of 9 rule XVIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives 10 is amended by adding at the end the following new para-11 graph:

12 "(h) Whenever a recorded vote on any question has 13 been decided by a margin within which the votes cast by the Delegates and the Resident Commissioner have been 14 15 decisive, the Committee of the Whole shall rise and the Speaker shall put such question de novo without inter-16 vening motion. Upon the announcement of the vote on 17 that question, the Committee of the Whole shall resume 18 its sitting without intervening motion.". 19
