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**Section 1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the "Protect Medical Innovation Act of 201~~7~~<sup>8</sup>".

**Sec. 2. Repeal of medical device excise tax**

- (a) IN GENERAL.— Chapter 32 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking subchapter E.
- (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—
  - (1) Subsection (a) of section 4221 of such Code is amended by striking the last sentence.
  - (2) Paragraph (2) of section 6416(b) of such Code is amended by striking the last sentence.
- (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.— The table of subchapters for chapter 32 of such Code is amended by striking the item relating to subchapter E.
- (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.— The amendments made by this section shall apply to sales after December 31, 201~~7~~<sup>9</sup>.
