 - 2 SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND SENSE OF THE HOUSE.

3 (a) FINDINGS.—The House of Representatives finds

1 (1) The Delegates and the Resident Commis-2 sioner are elected by more than 4.5 million Ameri-3 cans residing in United States territories and the 4 District of Columbia and take the same oath to up-5 hold the Constitution as other Members of Congress.

6 (2) Under the Rules of the House of Represent-7 atives, the Delegates and the Resident Commissioner 8 may sponsor and cosponsor legislation; offer amend-9 ments; participate in debate (including managing 10 time); offer motions, raise points of order and ques-11 tions of personal privilege; call a Member to order; 12 appeal rulings of the chair; file reports for committees: object to the consideration of a bill; and move 13 14 impeachment proceedings on the floor of the House.

(3) Under clause 3 of rule III of the Rules ofthe House of Representatives:

17 (A) Delegates and the Resident Commis18 sioner are elected to serve on standing commit19 tees in the same manner as other Members of
20 the House and have the same parliamentary
21 powers and privileges as other Members of the
22 House elected to such standing committees; and

(B) the Speaker of the House is authorized to appoint Delegates and the Resident Commissioner to select, joint, and conference commit-

tees in the same manner as other Members of
 the House.

3 (4)During the 103rd (1993-1994), 110th 4 (2007-2008) and 111th (2009-2010) Congresses, 5 the Rules of the House of Representatives permitted 6 Delegates and the Resident Commissioner to cast 7 votes in the Committee of the Whole House on the 8 state of the Union, subject to immediate reconsider-9 ation in the House when their recorded votes had 10 been decisive in the Committee.

(5) The Parliamentarian of the House has an
existing standard established by precedent to determine whether votes of the Delegates and the Resident Commissioner on a question were decisive.

15 (6) In the Committee of the Whole House on
16 the state of the Union, votes of the Delegates and
17 the Resident Commissioner were—

18 (A) decisive on three occasions in the
19 103rd Congress (1993-1994), and thus subject
20 to automatic revote by the House;

21 (B) in no instances decisive during the
22 110th Congress (2007-2008); and

23 (C) decisive on one occasion during the
24 111th Congress (2009-2010), and thus subject
25 to an automatic revote by the House.

1 (7) In 1994, the United States Court of Ap-2 peals for the District of Columbia Circuit ruled in Michel v. Anderson, 14 F.3d 623 (D.C. Cir. 1994), 3 4 upholding the constitutionality of permitting the 5 Delegates and Resident Commissioner to cast non-6 decisive votes in the Committee of the Whole House 7 on the state of the Union, under the Rules of the 8 House of Representatives.

9 (b) SENSE OF THE HOUSE.—It is the sense of the 10 House of Representatives that each Delegate and the Resi-11 dent Commissioner shall continue to be permitted to pre-12 side over the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union, pursuant to the first sentence of clause 1 13 of rule XVIII of the Rules of the House of Representa-14 15 tives, as amended by H.Res.5 (Adopting rules for the One 16 Hundred Fifteenth Congress) agreed to in the House on 17 January 3, 2017.

20 (a) PERMITTING VOTES TO BE CAST.—Clause 3(a)
21 of rule III of the Rules of the House of Representatives
22 is amended to read as follows:

23 "3. (a) In a Committee of the Whole House on the
24 state of the Union, each Delegate and the Resident Com25 missioner shall possess the same powers and privileges as

Members of the House. Each Delegate and the Resident
 Commissioner shall be elected to serve on standing com mittees in the same manner as Members of the House and
 shall possess in such committees the same powers and
 privileges as the other members of the committee.".

6 (b) REPEATING OF CERTAIN VOTES.—Clause 6 of
7 rule XVIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives
8 is amended by adding at the end the following new para9 graph:

10 "(h) Whenever a recorded vote on any question has been decided by a margin within which the votes cast by 11 12 the Delegates and the Resident Commissioner have been decisive, the Committee of the Whole shall rise and the 13 Speaker shall put such question de novo without inter-14 15 vening motion. Upon the announcement of the vote on that question, the Committee of the Whole shall resume 16 its sitting without intervening motion.". 17

(c) ESTABLISHING QUORUM IN COMMITTEE OF THE
WHOLE.—The first sentence of clause 6(a) of rule XVIII
of the Rules of the House of Representatives is amended
by inserting ", including Delegates and the Resident Commissioner" before the period at the end.
