Mr. NUGENT, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5544) to authorize and expedite a land exchange involving National Forest System land in the Laurentian District of the Superior National Forest and certain other National Forest System land in the State of Minnesota that has limited recreational and conservation resources and lands owned by the State of Minnesota in trust for the public school $\mathbf{2}$

system that are largely scattered in checkerboard fashion within the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness and have important recreational, scenic, and conservation resources, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5949) to extend the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 for five years.

1 Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5544) to authorize and expedite 6 a land exchange involving National Forest System land 7 in the Laurentian District of the Superior National Forest 8 and certain other National Forest System land in the 9 State of Minnesota that has limited recreational and con-10 servation resources and lands owned by the State of Minnesota in trust for the public school system that are large-11 12 ly scattered in checkerboard fashion within the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness and have important rec-13 14 reational, scenic, and conservation resources, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed 15 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill 16 17 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill 18 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-19 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the 20 Committee on Natural Resources. After general debate the

bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-1 minute rule. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of 2 3 a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural 4 Resources now printed in the bill, an amendment in the 5 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 112-30, modified by the amendment printed 6 7 in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-8 panying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted in 9 the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, 10 as amended, shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of further amendment under the five-minute 11 rule and shall be considered as read. All points of order 12 13 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. No further amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in 14 15 order except those printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules. Each such further amendment may 16 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may 17 18 be offered only by a Member designated in the report, 19 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time 20specified in the report equally divided and controlled by 21 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to 22 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-23 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee 24 of the Whole. All points of order against such further amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-25

1 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
2 and report the bill, as amended, to the House with such
3 further amendments as may have been adopted. The pre4 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
5 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto to
6 final passage without intervening motion except one mo7 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

8 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall 9 be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 5949) 10 to extend the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 for five years. All points of order against consideration of the bill 11 are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute 12 13 recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, 14 15 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are 16 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-17 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any amendment 18 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except: 19 (1) one hour of debate, with 40 minutes equally divided 20 21 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member 22 of the Committee on the Judiciary and 20 minutes equally 23 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority 24 member of the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-

- 1 ligence; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without
- 2 instructions.
