tions for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes, with 1 2 the House amendments to the Senate amendment thereto, 3 and to consider in the House, without intervention of any 4 point of order, a motion offered by the chair of the Committee on Appropriations or his designee that the House 5 recede from its amendments and concur in the Senate 6 amendment with the amendment printed in the report of 7 8 the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. 9 The Senate amendment and the motion shall be consid-10 ered as read. The motion shall be debatable for 40 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking 11 12 minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on 13 the motion to its adoption without intervening motion or 14 15 demand for division of the question.

16 SEC. 2. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII 17 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-18 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the 19 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported 20 through the legislative day of October 7, 2013.
