(2) The term "covered forfeited property" 3 means property forfeited under chapter 46 or section 4 5 1963 of title 18, United States Code, which property 6 belonged to, was possessed by, or was controlled by a person subject to sanctions and designated by the 7 8 Secretary of the Treasury or the Secretary of State, 9 or which property was involved in an act in violation 10 of sanctions enacted pursuant to Executive Order 14024, and as expanded by Executive Order 14066 11 12 of March 8, 2022, and relied on for additional steps taken in Executive Order 14039 of August 20, 13 14 2021, and Executive Order 14068 of March 11, 15 2022.

16 (d) The authority under this section shall apply to17 any covered forfeited property forfeited on or before May18 1, 2025.
