## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the House amendment to the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2617) to amend section 1115 of title 31, United States Code, to amend the description of how performance goals are achieved, and for other purposes; relating to consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill Z:\XML\XML\_196.XML

(H.R. 4373) making appropriations for the Department of State, foreign operations, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and for other purposes; relating to consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 1082) to prohibit the unauthorized sale of ride-hailing signage and study the incidence of fatal and non-fatal assaults in TNC and for-hire vehicles in order to enhance safety and save lives; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it 2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill 3 (H.R. 2617) to amend section 1115 of title 31, United 4 States Code, to amend the description of how performance 5 goals are achieved, and for other purposes, with the Sen-6 ate amendment to the House amendment to the Senate 7 amendment thereto, and to consider in the House, without 8 intervention of any point of order, a motion offered by the 9 chair of the Committee on Appropriations or her designee 10 that the House concur in the Senate amendment to the House amendment to the Senate amendment. The Senate 11 12 amendment and the motion shall be considered as read. 13 The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member 14 of the Committee on Appropriations or their respective 15 designees. The previous question shall be considered as or-16 17 dered on the motion to its adoption without intervening 18 motion.

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1 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution, the House 2 shall be considered to have taken from the Speaker's table 3 the bill (H.R. 4373) making appropriations for the De-4 partment of State, foreign operations, and related pro-5 grams for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, and 6 for other purposes, with the Senate amendment thereto, 7 and to have concurred in the Senate amendment.

8 SEC. 3. Senate Concurrent Resolution 51 is hereby9 adopted.

10 SEC. 4. House Resolution 366 is hereby adopted.

11 SEC. 5. Upon adoption of this resolution, the House 12 shall be considered to have taken from the Speaker's table the bill (H.R. 1082) to prohibit the unauthorized sale of 13 ride-hailing signage and study the incidence of fatal and 14 15 non-fatal assaults in TNC and for-hire vehicles in order to enhance safety and save lives, with the Senate amend-16 ments thereto, and to have concurred in the Senate 17 amendments. 18
