A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
 fiscal year ending September 30, 2024, and for other pur-

6 poses, namely:

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DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE, DEFENSE-WIDE (INCLUDING TRANSFER OF FUNDS)

5 For an additional amount for "Operations and Main-6 tenance, Defense-Wide", for the Defense Security Cooperation Agency, \$300,000,000, to remain available until 7 September 30, 2025, which shall be for the Ukraine Secu-8 rity Assistance Initiative: Provided, That such funds shall 9 10 be available to the Secretary of Defense, with the concur-11 rence of the Secretary of State, to provide assistance, in-12 cluding training; equipment; lethal assistance; logistics 13 support, supplies and services; salaries and stipends; 14 sustainment; and intelligence support to the military and 15 national security forces of Ukraine, and to other forces 16 or groups recognized by and under the authority of the 17 Government of Ukraine, including governmental entities within Ukraine, engaged in resisting Russian aggression 18 19 against Ukraine, for replacement of any weapons or arti-20cles provided to the Government of Ukraine from the in-21 ventory of the United States, and to recover or dispose 22 of equipment procured using funds made available in this 23 section in this or prior Acts: Provided further, That the 24 Secretary of Defense shall, not less than 15 days prior 25 to obligating funds made available in this section, notify

1 the congressional defense committees in writing of the de-2 tails of any such obligation: Provided further, That the 3 Secretary of Defense shall, not more than 60 days after 4 such notification is made, inform such committees if such funds have not been obligated and the reasons therefor: 5 6 Provided further, That the Secretary of Defense shall consult with such committees in advance of the provision of support provided to other forces or groups recognized by 8 9 and under the authority of the Government of Ukraine: Provided further, That the United States may accept 1011 equipment procured using funds made available in this section in this or prior Acts transferred to the security 12 forces of Ukraine and returned by such forces to the 13 14 United States: *Provided further*, That equipment procured using funds made available in this section in this or prior 15 16Acts, and not yet transferred to the military or national 17 security forces of Ukraine or to other assisted entities, or 18 returned by such forces or other assisted entities to the United States, may be treated as stocks of the Depart-19 ment of Defense upon written notification to the congres-2021 sional defense committees: Provided further, That any no-22tification of funds made available in this section in this 23 or prior Acts shall specify whether such funds support on-24 going or new programs, the duration and expected cost 25 over the life of each program, a timeline for the delivery

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of defense articles and defense services, and any equip-1 2 ment that requires enhanced end-use monitoring: *Provided further*, That the Secretary of Defense shall provide quar-3 terly reports to the congressional defense committees on 4 the use and status of funds made available in this section: 5 *Provided further*, That of the amounts provided under this 6 7 heading, \$20,000,000 shall be transferred to the Office 8 of Special Inspector General for Ukraine Assistance, as 9 established in section 103 of this Act.

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GENERAL PROVISIONS—THIS ACT

SEC. 101. Each amount appropriated or made available by this Act is in addition to amounts otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year involved.

14 SEC. 102. Unless otherwise provided for by this Act, 15 the additional amounts appropriated by this Act to appro-16 priations accounts shall be available under the authorities 17 and conditions applicable to such appropriations accounts 18 for fiscal year 2024.

SEC. 103. There is established the Office of the Special Inspector General for Ukraine Assistance for the following:

(1) To provide for the independent and objective conduct and supervision of audits and investigations, including within the territory of Ukraine, relating to the programs and operations funded with amounts appropriated

or otherwise made available for the military and non military support of Ukraine.

3 (2) To provide for the independent and objective lead-4 ership and coordination of, and recommendations on, poli-5 cies designed to prevent and detect waste, fraud, and 6 abuse in such programs and operations described in para-7 graph (1).

8 (3) To provide for an independent and objective 9 means of keeping the Secretary of State, the Secretary 10 of Defense, and Congress fully and currently informed 11 about problems and deficiencies relating to the adminis-12 tration of such programs and operations and the necessity 13 for and progress on corrective action.

This Act may be cited as the "Ukraine Security Assistance and Oversight Supplemental Appropriations Act,
2024".
