

David Zuckerman has been leading the Healthcare Anchor Network since its launch in 2017 and serves as the executive director of the network. He is a national thought leader on the role of health systems as anchor institutions in building community wealth and inclusive economic development.

David is the co-author of several reports that have helped propel forward the anchor mission movement, including *Hospitals Aligned for Healthy Communities* toolkit series. He is also the author of *Hospitals Building Healthier Communities: Embracing the Anchor Mission* and a contributor to *Can Hospitals Heal America's Communities*. He is the lead author of a National Academy of Medicine discussion paper, *Building a Culture of Health at the Federal Level* and a contributor to the *2020 Surgeon General's Report on Community Health and Economic Prosperity*.

David has been an invited speaker at key sector events hosted by the following organizations to promote the anchor mission movement: World Health Organization, American Hospital Association, Association of Academic Health Centers, the National Academy of Medicine, American Organization of Nurse Executives and *Modern Healthcare*.

He serves on the Board of Trustees for the Consumer Health Foundation, including previously as Treasurer.
