

Barbara Duffield is Executive Director of SchoolHouse Connection (SHC), a national organization working to overcome homelessness through education. For more than 20 years, Barbara has bridged policy and practice in early care, education, housing, and homelessness. She began her career as a tutor for children experiencing homelessness in Washington DC in 1990. Barbara served as the Director of Education for the National Coalition for the Homeless from 1994-2003, and as the Director of Policy and Programs at the National Association for the Education of Homeless Children and Youth in Washington D.C from 2003-2016. She established several national scholarship programs for youth who have experienced homelessness and wish to pursue higher education, including SHC's Youth Leadership & Scholarship program. Barbara has served on numerous commissions and advisory groups, including Sesame Street Workshop initiatives on childhood trauma, family homelessness, and racial justice. She was a member of the National Commission on Children and Disasters education group. Barbara is a co-author of Educating Children Without Housing: A Primer on Legal Requirements and Implementation Strategies for Educators, Advocates and Policymakers, and has been published in academic and practice journals. Barbara received her Bachelor's degree *summa cum laude* in Political Science from the University of Michigan.
