

Stephen Ritz is an internationally acclaimed, award-winning educator, author of best-selling book, [The Power Of A Plant](#) and Founder of [Green Bronx Machine](#). Known as America's favorite teacher and [2015 Top Ten Finalist for the Global Teacher Prize](#), Stephen is responsible for creating the first edible classroom in the world. He and his students have grown more than 130,000 pounds of vegetables in the South Bronx, were celebrated at the Obama White House three times, have been featured on the cover of TIME for KIDS, and are the subject of a new, full-feature documentary, [Generation Growth](#). Stephen serves as a Senior Fellow in Social Innovation at Babson College and as a Board Member for the NYC Nutrition Education Network.
