### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Separation of Powers3 Restoration Act of 2023" or "SOPRA".

4 SEC. 2. JUDICIAL REVIEW OF STATUTORY AND REGU-5 LATORY INTERPRETATIONS.

6 Section 706 of title 5, United States Code, is amend7 ed—

8 (1) by striking "To the extent necessary" and
9 inserting "(a) To the extent necessary";

10 (2) by striking "decide all relevant questions of
11 law, interpret constitutional and statutory provi12 sions, and";

(3) by inserting after "of the terms of an agency action" the following "and decide de novo all relevant questions of law, including the interpretation
of constitutional and statutory provisions, and rules
made by agencies. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this subsection shall apply in any action

for judicial review of agency action authorized under
 any provision of law. No law may exempt any such
 civil action from the application of this section ex cept by specific reference to this section"; and
 (4) by striking "The reviewing court shall—"

7 "(b) The reviewing court shall—".
