#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "DHS Restrictions on
3 Confucius Institutes and Chinese Entities of Concern
4 Act".

## 5 SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON CONFUCIUS INSTITUTES' HOST 6 SCHOOLS.

7 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

| 21 | (b) RESTRICTIONS ON INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER               |
| 22 | EDUCATION.—Beginning with the first fiscal year that be- |
| 23 | gins after the date that is 12 months after the date of  |
| 24 | the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Se- |

25 curity shall ensure that an institution of higher education

(referred to in this subsection as an "institution") which 1 2 has a relationship with a Confucius Institute or Chinese 3 entity of concern is ineligible to receive any funds from the Department of Homeland Security, unless the institu-4 5 tion terminates the relationship between the institution and such Confucius Institute or Chinese entity of concern, 6 7 as the case may be. Upon termination of such a relationship, the institution at issue shall be eligible to receive 8 funds from the Department of Homeland Security. 9
